

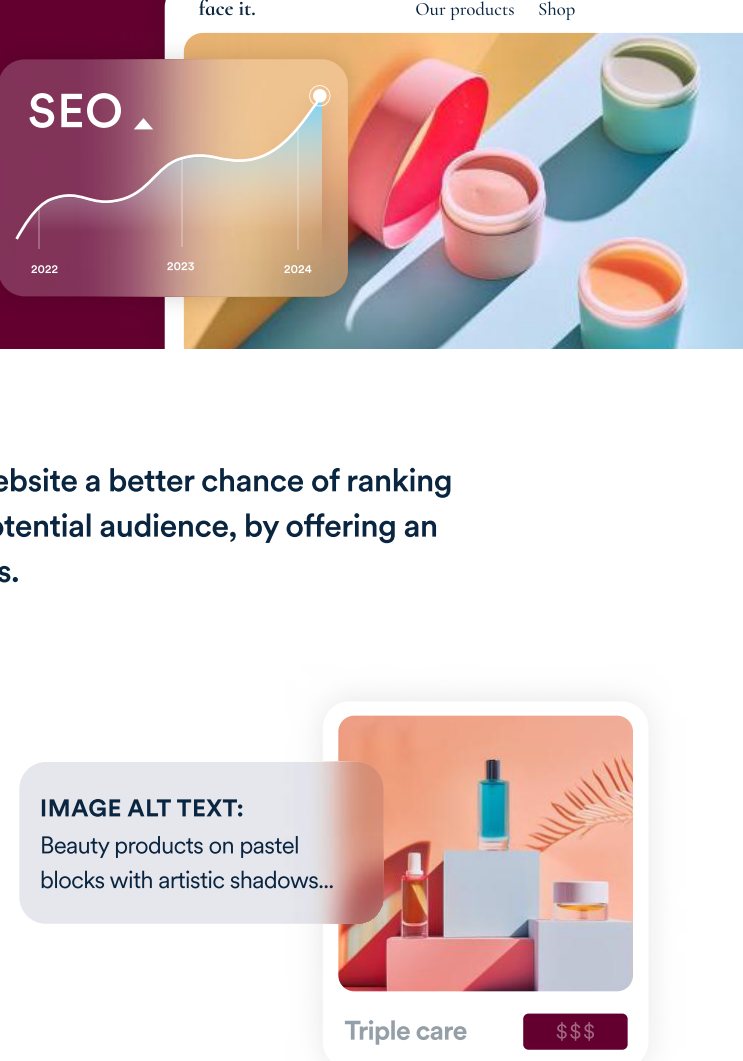
Top 10 SEO tips

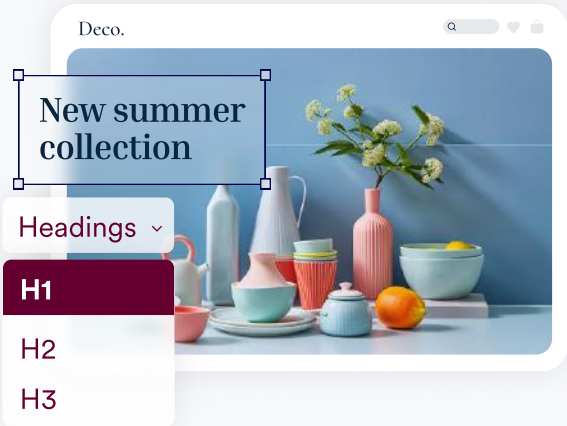
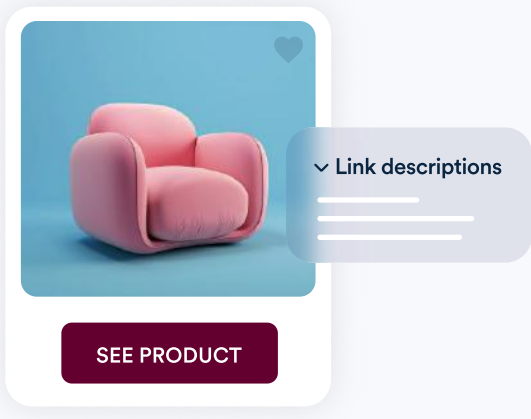
Add structured data and schema markup:

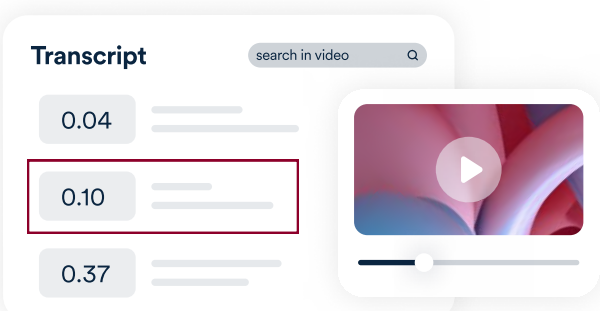
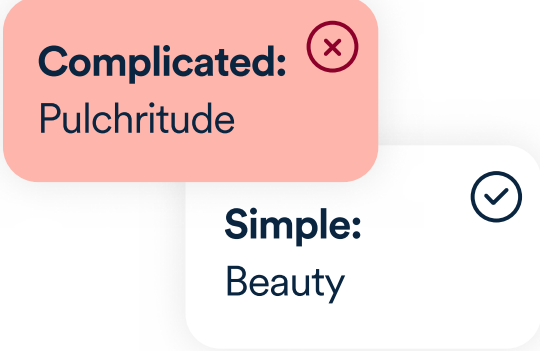
Use descriptive link text:

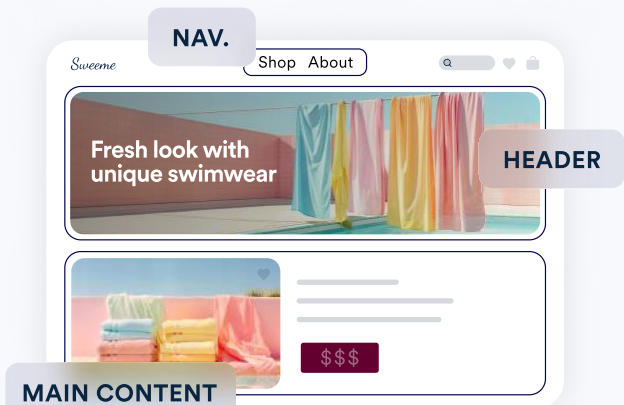
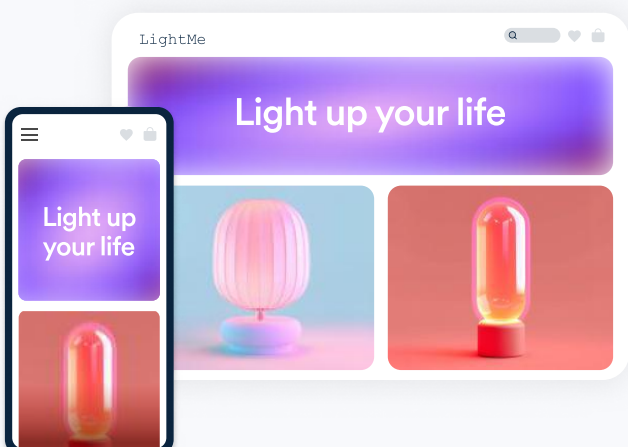
Add transcripts to videos:

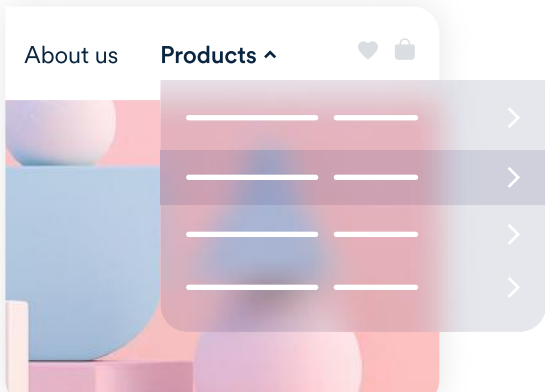
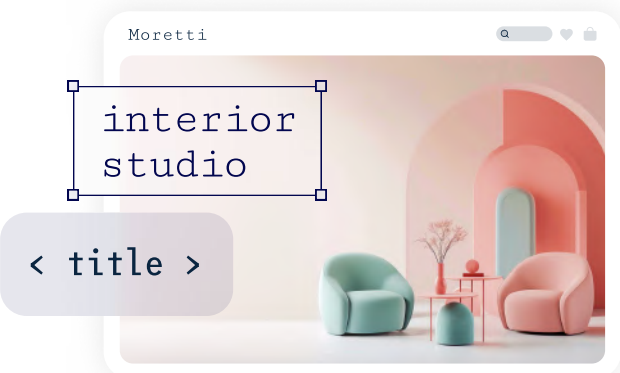
Add ARIA Landmarks:
